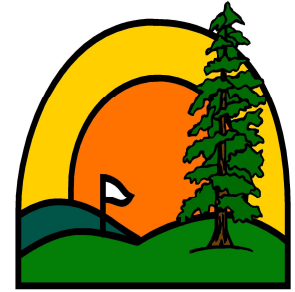

It's that time of year again!! Greens aerification is just a few weeks away! We are scheduled to begin aerification August 13th and hope to be finished on the 15th. This is of course dependent upon the weather, but should any changes be made we will let you know. While a minor inconvenience to play, this is the most important thing that we do to keep improving the playability of our greens. Our goal is to have the greens completely healed in 14 days. July was a challenging month, but all in all the course made it through the tough weather quite well. It gave us a chance to catch up on mowing down the naturalized areas throughout the course. Along with aerification this month we are also beginning to clean out 11 fairway bunker. The plan is to get everything prepared for new sand some time in September. We also will be repairing and replacing some boards on the bridges. We are currently preparing boards and will begin replacing boards on bridges throughout this month and the next.
