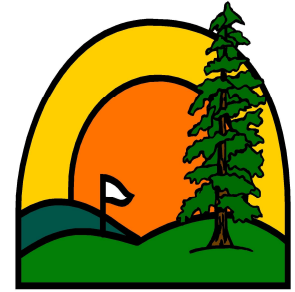

Greens aerification is just a few weeks away! We are scheduled to begin aerification August 16th and hope to be finished on the 18th. This is, of course, dependent upon the weather but should any changes be made we will let you know. We will be pulling a ½” core from the greens and filling those holes with sand. This will greatly benefit the new greens as it will help smooth out the bumps that are still left from when the sod was laid this spring. While a minor inconvenience to play, this is the most important thing that we do to keep improving the playability of our greens. Our goal is to have the greens completely healed in 14 days.
