Moving forward into June, our focus will be to finish edging the bunkers and to finish mulching the flower beds. We will also begin to mow down • the naturalized areas which will take two to three weeks. The plan for greens will be for two light applications of topdressing before the 4<sup>th</sup> of July. These will have no impact on play or the quality of the putting surface.
