"From the Course"

Fall is just around the corner although with the current weather pattern we wouldn't know it. The greens have healed in nicely from aerification and that will make for a great fall for golf. With the greens now healed we will continue working on some course improvement projects. The fairway bunker on #11 is ready for sand and will be finished in the coming weeks. We will also continue to move soil to fill in the bunker left of 16 green. It will be seeded and grown in before the end of the growing season.

We will begin to remark the edges of greens and collars. Over the season both edges become out of line by the daily mowing of the triplex mowers. You may notice that some collars are very skinny while 10 feet away it may be twice as wide. We will mark the correct edges with paint as a guide for the mowers and bring them back to the correct place. The last change around the greens will be a step cut around the collar on every green. We will continue the step cut that is around the fairways and continue it around the greens. This will improve the lie just off the collar.
