

With the golf season finally underway, I would like to remind everyone of a few things you can do as golfers to help keep Lone Pine looking and playing its best. First, please repair your ballmarks. You guys have been doing a great job this spring and just keep it up. Second, please use caution when driving throughout the course. The wet spring, we have faced is leaving areas more saturated than normal and they are not drying out as fast. Lastly, please avoid parking golf carts close to the greens. If you can walk onto the green within 3-5 steps, you are parked too close!! Please, remember to fill your divots with green sand located on your carts and in the divot boxes next to tee's.

Looking ahead to this week. We will be aerifying greens with solid tines once again and topdressing right after. We will continue to try and keep up with the growing grass and give you guys the best playability as possible. This month, 13 fairway damage that happened this winter will be fixed and 12 drainage project will be leveled and seeded.
